


Reading Scales Easter Baking Challenge Cards


This is a set of different challenge activities for LKS2 children to practise their understanding of measuring, adding and subtracting; lengths (mm, cm, m), mass (g, kg) and volume (ml, l). Estimate, compare and calculate different measures, convert between units of measure and to solve problems using measure.

1. To make hot cross buns I need 250g

2. I need to mix some Easter cupcakes but all of the ingredients are on the scales at the same time. The scale reads 950q.

I know the mass of the flour is as much as the sugar and sultanas together. What is the mass of the flour?

Challenge: The mass of sugar is 2/5, the mass of the sultanas is 3/5. What is the mass of the sultanas?


3. I need to convert some quantities in the recipes I am going to try. Match the equivalent quantities below with a line.


4. From the scales shown, state what each labelled interval represents.

5. What is the mass of flour on these scales?


If I add another 75g of flour, draw the pointer at the correct place on the scales.

Challenge: Record the volume of juice in ml and l.

If so by how much?

8. The total mass of a bowl and ingredients for Easter cupcakes is 490g. Nine equal spoonfuls of mixture will fill the cupcake cases. When three cupcake cases are filled, the mass of the bowl and ingredients is 340g.

What is the mass of the missing bowl?
