Greater Depth Tick the set of fractions that are ordered correctly. Unit and non-unit fractions with different denominators within twelfths using knowledge of equivalent fractions. No pictorial support.

Questions 3, 6 and 9 (Reasoning and Problem Solving)

Developing Explain if the fractions have been ordered correctly. Unit fractions or fractions with the same denominator. Halves, quarters and thirds only. With pictorial support.

Expected Explain if the fractions have been ordered correctly. Unit fractions or fractions with the same denominator within twelfths. Some pictorial support.

Greater Depth Explain if the fractions have been ordered correctly. Unit fractions or fractions with the same denominator within twelfths using knowledge of equivalent fractions.





<u>Developing</u>

1. C, D, B, A, E

3. Chen is incorrect because $\frac{1}{4}$ is smaller than $\frac{2}{4}$.

The correct order is $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{1}{4}$.

Expected

4. D, C, E, A, F, B

6. Suzie is incorrect because $\frac{2}{8}$ is smaller than $\frac{5}{8}$.

The correct order is $\frac{7}{8}$, $\frac{5}{8}$, $\frac{2}{8}$.

Greater Depth
7. B, E, F, A, D, C

9. All is incorrect because $\frac{1}{2}$ is the smallest amount and $\frac{4}{6}$ is smaller than $\frac{6}{8}$.

The correct order is $\frac{6}{8}$, $\frac{4}{6}$, $\frac{1}{2}$.
