

Coordinates Spelling Game

Working with a partner, decide who will be noughts and who will be crosses. The first player needs to throw two dice and map the coordinate that they make on the spelling coordinate grid - the first dice shows how far you need to go across the x-axis and the second dice shows how far you need to go up the y-axis.

Use the adverb in that square within a sentence. If you manage to create a sensible sentence, cross off that square using your chosen symbol. The first player to get three squares in a row is the winner!
