## Remote Learning Arrangements

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you and your families are keeping well. We are continuing to take all of the precautions we can and routines are working well at the moment.

We've been planning ahead in case we have to move to remote learning for individual pupils, bubbles or the whole school. Our priority is to provide a seamless transition between learning in school and at home to cause as little disruption as possible. It is important that we communicate the plans to you so that in the event of a closure, you know what to expect.

**Purple Mash** – Many of you are confident with this platform and we will continue to use this for a variety of different subjects. There is a facility to record a message for children to guide them with tasks and they can leave a feedback message for teachers too. Links to White Rose maths be put on here.

**Classroom Secrets Kids** – This is a new site which we have evaluated as being useful for maths, English reading and grammar. We will look at this with the children in school and send home their individual logins. This site will be used for any individuals who are isolating.

**Espresso** – This site has a variety of subjects and one we used during lockdown.

**Oak Academy** – This is really useful for children to go on to do some additional learning based on their interests. The science, art and history activities seem particularly good.

**Times Tables Rock Stars and Numbots** (the same login for both.)

In the event of a bubble/whole school closure, the teachers will organise a **Teams meeting** with all children being invited at 9.30am in the morning. We will be sending home the individual details for this.

You will be kept updated with any further measures if they were to become necessary.
