

Painting Portraits

KS1/KS2



Workshop Overview:

Children will visit our gallery of portraits and learn more about the characters by stepping into their shoes and minds, using dressing up and hot-seating.

Your class will look at how different artists have approached portraiture through time. Participants will learn how to draw a face in proportion, colour mixing techniques and experiment with different ways to apply paint to create their own portrait to take back to school.

Curriculum Links:

Art & Design

KS1 Pupils will:

- use a range of materials creatively to design and make artwork
- use drawing and painting techniques to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination
- develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, line, shape and tone
- learn about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.

KS2 Pupils will:

- develop their techniques, including their control and their use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of art, craft and design.
- use sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas
- improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing and painting with a range of materials
- learn about the work of other artists from history
- evaluate and analyse creative works using the language of art, craft and design
